

Albury Rimfire & Air Rifle Shooting Classic

Where: Barr Reserve, Wangaratta SBR Club

When: 4th & 5th April 2020

Shooting: Starts at 9.30am Saturday and 9.00am Sunday

Saturday: 50 Metre Prone – 60 shots

Saturday: 50 Metre Benchrest – 60 Shots B/M

Saturday and Sunday: 10 Metre Air Rifle and Supported Air Rifle – walk up start.

One 60 shot match to be shot on either Saturday or Sunday.

Sunday: 50 Metre Prone – 60 Shots M/M

Sunday: 50 Metre Bench Rest - 60 shots

Both days: Aggregate of both days in Prone and Benchrest 1_{st} 2_{nd} and 3_{rd} place medals 1_{st} Junior and 1_{st} Veteran medals. Top 5 in both grades awarded cloth patches with 6_{th} to 10_{th} place receiving numbered medals. Automatic entry to Aggregate match.

TRV state grades will be used to determine awards. 1st, 2nd and 3rd medals awarded in each grade, along with 1st Junior and 1st Veteran medals.

ENTRY FEE: Seniors and Veterans: \$15.00 per match.

Juniors: \$12.00 per match.

Entries close: Each day at 12noon for rimfire events. Last detail each day for walk up start in the air range will be 1pm. With all matches shot on paper targets. **ASBRC inc.**, reserves the rights to alter the program at anytime.

Veterans all events: 65 years as per master marksmen and bench master TRV directive.

Benchrest will be shot on TRA approved 20 spot targets. Backing cards to be used for rimfire shooting.

*ISSF and Australian supplementary rules apply.

All shooters will be required to supply state membership status, address and current shooter's license may be witnessed with license number and expiry date required on entry form.

"Pre Entries" are not a requirement but will be accepted prior to the event.
